



SETTING UP 2FA (TWO FACTOR AUTHENTICATION)

The instructions below will show you how to add/use Microsoft's Authenticator app for periodic identity verification when using outlook or accessing email. If you encounter any issues along the way and need additional support, please reach out to support@bravertechnology.com (508-824-2260). If you already have an authenticator app installed on your phone, you can use that and add the authorization on to it.

1. On your mobile phone, download + open Microsoft Authenticator app.

- You will be immediately prompted to add your account. Press Add account.
- You will be given options on the type of account; Select "Work or school account".
- At this point, your camera will turn on looking for a QR code. Complete #2 below, Then you will return to the phone and scan the QR code on your computer screen.

2. On your computer sign in to: <https://aka.ms/MFASetup>

*If you are NOT already logged in to Microsoft you will see:

- login with your email address and password when prompted. Press Next.
- You will be informed that we require additional information before you can continue. Press next.
- You will be asked how you wish to be notified. In the dropdown, select **Mobile App**. In the selection box select **Receive notifications for verification**.
- Click Set up (go to step 3)

*If you are logged in to Microsoft you will see:

- Check off Authentication phone enter your mobile phone number in the box.
- Check off Authenticator app or Token
- Click Set up Authenticator app (go to step 3).

3. A QR code will appear on the screen. Scan with your phone using the Microsoft Authenticator App. Once complete, you will see a similar image. You may now close this application.

4. Return to your PC. Press Next and wait for verification to complete. Once verification completes, you may Press Save and exit this browser. The process is complete.

*If you receive an additional 'Security Verification' page, please press done and bypass the notification. This is not required for our environment.

What Happens Now?

Sometimes when you are logging in and opening outlook or accessing your email from http://outlook.office.com you will see authorization request pop up. With this prompt, you should receive a notification on your phone, to approve sign in. Please Click Approve; This will happen from time to time but will not be a daily occurrence. This process is a vital security mechanism to protect our entire organization.
